Course Description and Objectives:

Successful oral rehabilitation with dental implants in the maxillary esthetic zone can be challenging and relies upon communication between patient, restoring dentist, dental laboratory technician, and implant surgeon. The purpose of this presentation is to briefly review basic dental implant principles and show how they are applied in selected case examples to the anterior maxilla. Also, as tooth replacement with dental implants has become more frequent over the previous years, the presentation will highlight case examples where treatment plans must be developed in consideration of existing implants. At the end of the presentation, the participant will:
